Main Range merino stud was founded in 2009 when 100 ewes passed official inspection. The merino flock was based on Merryville and Snowy Plain bloodlines for 50 years, under the stewardship of Greg Tozer. Two of the top priced pens of Merryville cfa superfine ewes were added to the flock in 1999 and 2000. At Main Range we aim to breed a balanced merino, with equal emphasis placed on constitution and body size and also on the production of long soft stapled, superior performing wools. To accomplish this aim, the cutting ability and commercial performance of Cottage Park (flock no. 2300)genetics have been used to complement the beautiful wools from Demondrille (flock no. 3994)stud rams. More recently sires from Yarrawonga and Roseville Park have been purchased and used.

- 1. Boudjah Ram Check

On Sunday the 14th September 2025, a veterinary examination was conducted of this year's Boudjah Sale Rams. The aim of the "Vet Check" is to ensure that all rams are fit and fertile for sale time. This examination has been carried out on Boudjah rams for over 20yrs, so clients can be confident that rams are satisfactory and that they are meeting exceptional standards. They are scrutinized by a team of people; veterinarians and graziers, along with wool industry experts.

The veterinary side of the process starts as the rams are walking into and around the yards. This allows examination of overall soundness, and body condition score; with any generalized remarks noted.

Each ram is individually assessed during the exam on a variety of aspects, most relating to fertility and ability to work, but also general health and biosecurity risks.

Each ram is individually identified with an electronic tag (located in the ear). This is recorded alongside their exam results.

Body Condition Score (BCS) is the first examination point as the ram enters the sheep handler. This allows for a general assessment of the overall health of the animal. If it seems to "fit in" with the rest of the mob, it inadvertently tells us that it's eating well and there isn't any grave health issue. Rams should be at a BCS of no less than 3 (on a 1 to 5 scale), trending toward 4 before joining.

Eyes are assessed for clarity and to make sure no growths, injuries or irritations are present.

We then move onto what is deemed to be the **most important** part of a Ram examination; the 4 Ts.

Teeth - This allows identification of age. The mouth and oral cavity are also assessed for any lesions/injuries. During examination of the teeth, the cheeks and nose are also assessed due to proximity to the area.

Toes - The feet are examined to assess conformation, redness/irritation, purulent discharge, under-running of sole or foul smelling discharge. This helps rule out abscess formations and foot rot. A normal foot has a hard wall of horn around two toes, each with a softer sole horn at the base. A healthy foot has pale pink and dry interdigital skin. A healthy foot will also show no abnormalities of horn growth.

Foot shape and structure are crucial in picking rams, when thinking about the amount of walking they do during breeding season. It is also critical when thinking about footrot, as structure and shape affect susceptibility.

During examination of the feet, the legs are also assessed. **Testicles** - This is all about palpation of the testicles and underlying structures along with scrotal circumference. Uniformity and firmness of the testicles is vitally important. soft flabby testicles are usually an indication of poor fertility. The scrotum is assessed for thickenings/injuries or abscesses that are likely to interfere with cooling (vital in sperm production). The spermatic cords are palpated for swellings/abscesses. The head, body and tail of the epididymis are again assessed for swellings/abnormalities that will likely interfere with movement of sperm from testicles to the penis. If everything palpates normally, a scrotal circumference measurement is taken. Scrotal circumference is correlated to daily sperm production. Larger testicles in sires are shown to have positive effects on daughters they produced. These daughters are likely to reach puberty earlier and ovulate more ova each cycle.

Any animal with a scrotal circumference of less than 32cm is removed.

Tossle (penis) - this is started by assessment of the prepuce for any damage, making sure the penis can protrude. The penis is then exteriorized and assessed for redness/sores along with any obvious injuries or infections.

Any animal deemed to have failed any aspect of the examination is removed from the sale team. Every effort has been made to keep these animals isolated between inspection and sale.

The above examination is a time specific examination and thus it is recommended that once rams are home and settled in; they again be examined prior to joining. We recommend that this occurs 6-8wks before joining, and be done on an annual basis.




